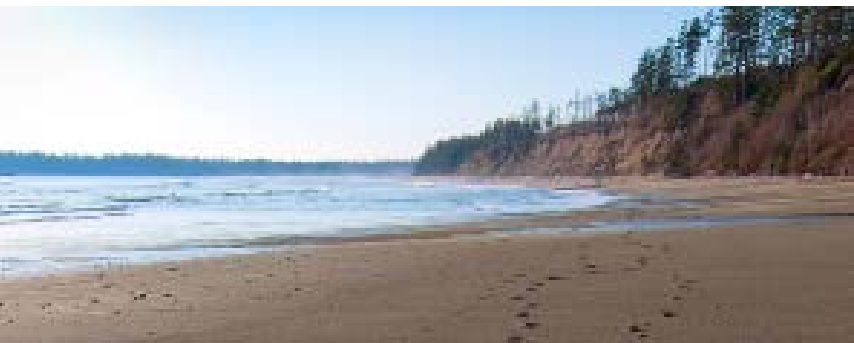
ST. LAWRENCE CRUISES
