AUGRABIES FALLS

HLULHLUWE-IMFOLOZI PARK

This is the oldest proclaimed nature reserve in Africa. With a variety of South African rich wildlife on offer, don't forget to pack your camera!

Whether near Durban, Port Elizabeth, Knysna or the "Garden Route", the coastline is marked out by a succession of beaches perfect for surfing, lagoons, estuaries and humid forests.

KALAHARI DESERT

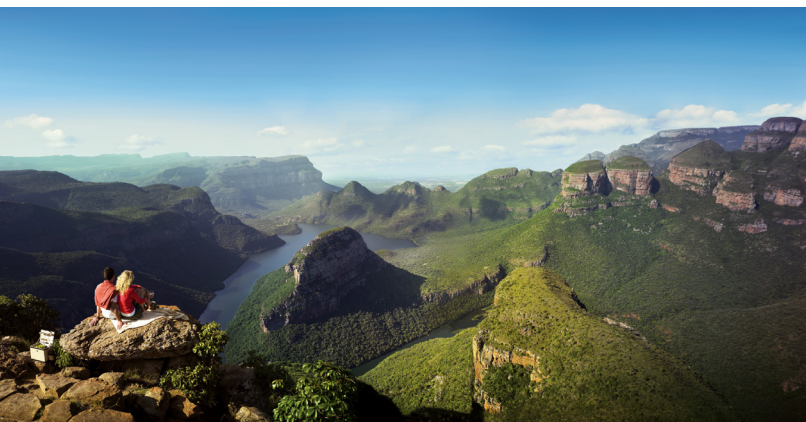
The largest semi-arid sandy savanna. It is home to wild animals such as African big cats (cheetah, leopard, African big cats), meerkat and cape fox.

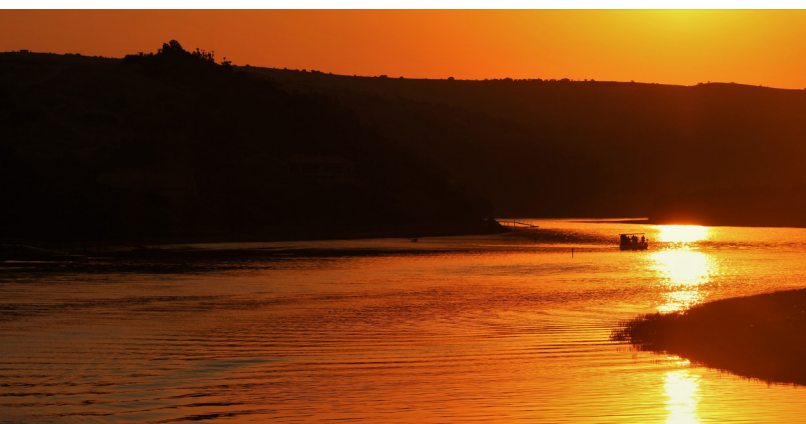
MPUMALANGA

The Blyde River Canyon is a 26km long canyon located in Mpumalanga and is one of the largest canyons on earth. This spectacular gorge is home to an abundance of wildlife.



NAMAQUALAND

Bright colourful daisies grow a route that stretches 80 kilometres from Cape Town to Port Nolloth. It is a biodiversity hotspot with the highest concentration of succulents and more than 1,000 types of flowers that found nowhere else on Earth.



ORANGE RIVER

PILANESBERG NATIONAL PARK

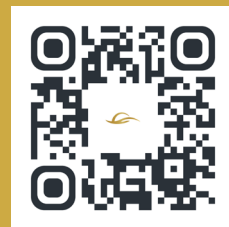
